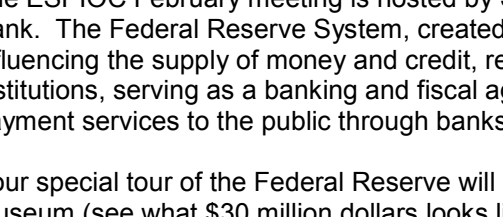
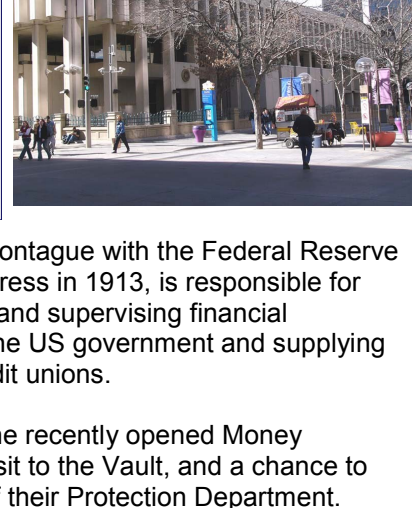


February 2011 Membership Meeting!



**This month we tour the
FEDERAL RESERVE BANK!**



The ESPIOC February meeting is hosted by Stacey Montague with the Federal Reserve Bank. The Federal Reserve System, created by Congress in 1913, is responsible for influencing the supply of money and credit, regulating and supervising financial institutions, serving as a banking and fiscal agent for the US government and supplying payment services to the public through banks and credit unions.

Your special tour of the Federal Reserve will include the recently opened Money Museum (see what \$30 million dollars looks like!), a visit to the Vault, and a chance to tour their new state of the art firing range that is part of their Protection Department.

We will also have a roundtable discussion on coordinated media when there are access issues – such as entering a restricted area like the Federal Reserve, a crime scene or a wildfire area where it might not be safe for reporters.

Directions -

From the north: Take I-25 to the Speer exit, turn left toward downtown. Turn left on Lawrence, right on 14th, then left on Curtis.

From the south: Take I-25 to the Colfax exit, turn right, then left on Speer, right on Stout (under the Convention Center), left on 15th, right on Curtis.

Parking is available at meters along the streets or in several surface parking lots nearby. There is also underground parking if you go up Curtis and turn left into the garage just past the 16th Street Mall.
