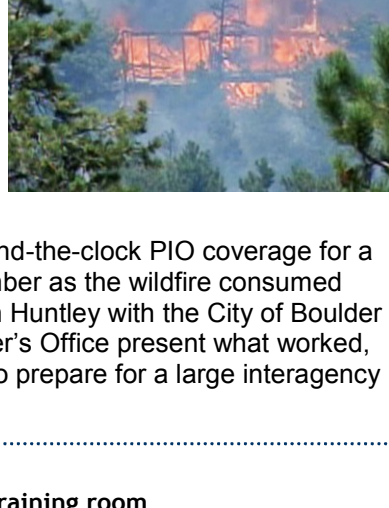
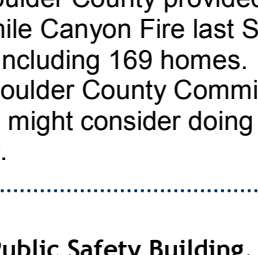
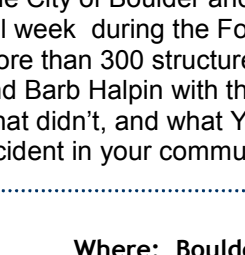

The City of Boulder and Boulder County provided around-the-clock PIO coverage for a full week during the Fourmile Canyon Fire last September as the wildfire consumed more than 300 structures, including 169 homes.
